Faculty, Mathematics

The faculty will teach a full load (15 credits/semester) in Mathematics. Specific courses may include, but will not be limited to: Business Mathematics, Developmental Math (Pre-Algebra, Elementary Algebra), Introduction to Mathematics, Statistics, Geometry, and College Algebra and Trigonometry. The focus of this position is on excellence in teaching with research recognized and valued but not required. Position will start Fall 2009 semester, August 13, 2009.

Minimum qualifications include a Master's Degree in Mathematics, Mathematics Education, or closely related discipline with emphasis and coursework in advanced Mathematics; four years of full-time teaching experience in mathematics, or one year of equivalent full-time teaching experience in mathematics at the college level; and familiarity with the use of technology in mathematics instruction, including microcomputers and graphing calculators. An earned Doctorate or Doctorate near completion in Mathematics, Mathematics Education, or closely related discipline with emphasis in Mathematics and/or Statistics is highly desired. Finalists will be required to present a sample lesson.
