Demonstrated successful experience teaching mathematics at the community college or baccalaureate level is desired. Experience teaching online courses and the ability to use computers and software packages currently available to support modern curriculum is desired.
Other:	Evidence of a sensitivity to and understanding of the diverse academic, socioeconomic, cultural, disability, and ethnic backgrounds of community college students (E.C. 87360a).
